

2017 Environmental Stewardship, Social Responsibility and Governance (ESG) Snapshot



Prologis is the global leader in logistics real estate. The principles of environmental stewardship, social responsibility and governance (ESG) are a natural fit in our business strategy. ESG is good business. It aligns with our longstanding commitment to be a valued partner for our customers and an exemplary citizen, minimizing our environmental impacts and maximizing returns for our stakeholders.

We set goals, establish strategies, track progress and report outcomes across our global portfolio for the three dimensions of ESG. Below is a summary of our ESG accomplishments as of year-end 2017.

Environmental Stewardship

Sustainable building certifications

- 112 MSF (10 MSQM) across 304 projects in 17 countries.
- In 2016, we added 63 projects (19 MSF).

Energy-efficient operations

 Approximately 82% of our operating portfolio has energyefficient lighting (based on 96% of the portfolio surveyed).

Solar energy

- Total solar footprint of 175 MW of generating capacity in 9 countries equating to clean power for 26,000 average homes each year.
- Increased solar portfolio by more than 10 MW in 2017.

Cool roofs

 Approximately 40% of our operating portfolio (254 MSF) has reflective roofing, which can reduce roof surface temperatures by as much as 50°F.

Environmental Benefits

LED lighting is at least 35% more efficient than traditional warehouse lighting, and is the standard in all new development projects and lighting retrofits. Our LED specification and procurement program delivers high-quality, flexible lighting solutions that materially reduce electricity and maintenance costs, improve operational efficiency for our customers, and diminish environmental impacts and the effects of climate change.

Volunteer hours
